• The supply cord cannot be replaced. If the cord is damaged the appliance should be scrapped.



- Children from 3 years and less than 8 years shall not plug in, regulate and clean the appliance or perform user maintenance.




- Do not use outside or in damp / wet conditions.

- Do not use the appliance to vacuum inflammable substances, like cigarettes and hot ashes.
- Keep the openings free to avoid blockage, like hair and loose clothing that may reduce air flow.
- Do not use without filters in place.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs. To avoid personal injury or damage, and to prevent the cleaner from falling.
- Do not place cleaner on stairs or furniture, as it may result in injury or damage.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or sawdust or use in areas where they may be present.
- Store the vacuum cleaner indoors. Put the vacuum cleaner away after use to prevent tripping hazards.




LOCATION OF CONTROLS



WALL MOUNTING


Choose location near power outlet. Locate point high enough on wall to allow tube and power brush to hand freely. Place wall mount against wall and use pencil to mark drill holes. Drill holes(with 1/4"bit) and insert drywall anchors. Insert screws through holes on mount and tighten until firmly attached.



Slide tube onto main body until it clicks Push tube into power brush or Crevice Tool until it clicks



OPERATION




- 1. Please do not use vacuum with plug connected.
- 2. Remove the battery before disposal of the vacuum cleaner.
- 3. The vacuum cleaner must be serviced or repaired by a specialised technician.

CHARGING

The battery must be fully charged before the first use. The product is delivered with the battery not charged. Place the product on the wall mount.

1. Connect socket and appliance with adaptor and cord, and power indicator flickers.






Place main body on flat surface when recharged.

Connect socket and main body with adaptor and cord and power indicator flickers.

Tip: In case of dropping appliance should be charged horizontally without brush and extension tube



CHARGING TIME:

General charging time 4-6 hours

WORKING TIME:

Turbo mode ≥15 min, Normal mode ≥35 min

Tips

- **1.** Please do not charge if the ambient temperature is lower than 5 or higher than 40.
- **2.** Insufficient power indicator for quantity of electricity flickers when you get an insufficient power in operation process.

BATTERY CHARGING:


- 1. It may take you longer time for charging under the following circumstances :
 - a. Room temperature is higher than 30;
 - b. Recharge immediately after the vacuum cleaner has stopped operating.
- 2. Always recharge the vacuum cleaner after each usage no matter how long it has been used.
- **3.** Unplug when not charging.
- **4.** When not in use for more than two months the vacuum cleaner should be disconnected from the power supply. To ensure a longer service life, the vacuum cleaner must be charged once every two months.
- **5.** The vacuum cleaner or adapter may become hot during charging so take the necessary precautions to avoid contact.



USING THE VACUUM

To prevent obstructions large pieces (for example big paper scraps, packaging film) should be removed in advance before vacuuming.

- **1.** Click "Power button" for cleaning.
- 2. Press "MAX" to switch between intense TURBO cleaning and energy savings NORMAL suction modes.
- **3.** Click "Power button" to stop cleaning.




STORAGE

Place the product on the wall mount. Connect socket and appliance with adaptor and cord.

DUST REMOVAL & HEPA FILTER CLEANING

Please remove the dust regularly to ensure constant suction.


Remove tube before emptying. Hold vacuum over waste basket. Press lever to release bottom lid of dust cup to empty the dust cup.




Twist filter clockwise and remove. Lift out filter and carefully remove the stainless steel strainer to expose the HEPA filter.

Remove any debris with a soft brush. Rinse and dry THOROUGHLY. Assemble after each part once dried completely.

HEPA cannot be wash

To prevent injuries handle with care.

- 1. Do not wash the mechanical part of the dust collector.
- 2. Ensure each part dried completely before next usage.
- 3. Do not scrub the filter or apply undue force.
- 4. Ensure filter is correctly secured during assembly.
- 5. Change filter if damaged or if cleaning does not return it to its original state.




BRUSH HEAD CLEANING

Please clean the brush when the brush roller or the wheel is entangle by hair.

1. Disassemble the power brush.



2. Using a flathead screwdriver or coin, turn screw to the 'unlock' position. Disassemble brush roll for cleaning and reassemble after all parts are completely dried.



Tip: The brush roll and its cover are washable. Ensure they are completely dry before use.

- 1. When the dust blocks the air flow of the floor brush please clean it.
- 2. Except for the brush roller and its cover, all other parts cannot be washed with water.
- 3. Do not apply oil to both ends of the brush roller.
- 4. Do not touch the working brush roll part and stay away from the air outlet when in operation.
- 5. Do not use when wheels or scrubber's nylon loop are damaged.

TROUBLESHOOTING

power brush does not work	Brush is trapped by hair or larger debris.	• Ensure that no hair or other thread is trapped around the brush and check brush area for larger debris.
Running time shortened	 Battery needs to be replaced. Ambient temperature is too high or too low. Battery is no fully changed. 	 Contact the shop or after sales service to replace the battery fat the user's own cost. Your vacuum should only be operated in suitable ambient temperature. The battery needs charging.
The vacuum has no suction power	 The dust cup is full. The filter is blocked. Suction inlet of brush or other accessory is blocked Parts of the appliance .is not fully dried after cleaning. 	 Clean the dust cup after use to prevent build ups. Remove any dust or debris from the filter. Check for blockages at brush and other attachment points. Ensure that all components are properly dried after washing.
MAX indicator flickers	• The filter or duct are blocked.	Clean the dust filter, dust cup and air duct.
No charging	Ambient temperature when charging is too low or too high.	• Charge the machine under the right temperature environment(5°-40°).
